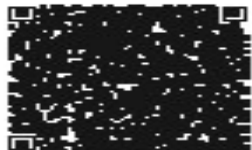

Columbia Center for Theatrical Arts, and has directed most of the productions at Toby's Dinner Theatre of Columbia since it's opening in 1979. Since 1975, Toby has been the creative force behind *The Young Columbians*, a touring musical troupe that has played at the White House and Wolf Trap among other places. In the last twenty-five years, Toby's Dinner Theatre has received over 120 Helen Hayes Award Nominations. Toby herself has been nominated 12 times and won the 2003 Helen Hayes Award for her direction of *Jekyll and Hyde*.



**MARK MINNICK** (*Associate Producer/Casting/Director*)

Over the years, Mark has received 15 Helen Hayes Award nominations for his Direction and or Choreography. He is extremely proud of the work he and his team of artists have created over the years. Productions of *Monty Python's Spamalot*, Disney's *The Little Mermaid*, *Crazy for You*, *West Side Story*, *Mamma Mia*, *Young Frankenstein*, *Grease*, *The SpongeBob Musical*, *Kinky Boots*, *Elf* and many, many more have entertained thousands all over the world and he is so proud to have cultivated such a rich, full life in the theatrical industry. Prior to joining the Toby's team full-time, Mark spent 15 years as Producer/Casting Director for Phoenix Entertainment.
